
Eliodor was a gifted young student, but his parents didn't have the resources to give him the best education available. Through hard work and determination, he graduated high school, something achieved by only 2% of Haitian students. And most schooling is totally out of reach for the 200,000+ Haitian children in domestic servitude.

A SCHOLARSHIP

After much deliberation and encouragement from his community, Eliodor heard God's call to become a pastor. But like the majority of Haitian church leaders, he couldn't afford seminary. Then he was given an opportunity: a scholarship through Haiti Partners. "Haiti Partners gave me more than a scholarship to study for ministry. They are my mentors."


A NEW VISION

3. Apprenticing in our work of following Jesus and working for justice




